** Gold level financial institutions set a floor annual net yield at 1.5% or higher and tie the interest rates on IOLTAs to a recognized market indicator less an established number of basis points. For example, a Gold level financial institution might tie at 50 or 100 basis points less than the Federal Funds Rate.*
